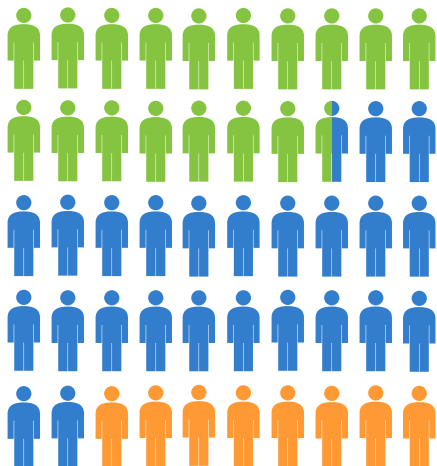

## OVERVIEW

Catholic Charities agencies and affiliates report that 2,759 local Catholic Charities service sites provided help and created hope for 9,035,223 unduplicated clients in 2013. All together, Catholic Charities agencies and affiliates report providing client services 17,283,889 times, ranging from fulfilling basic needs for clothing and shelter to developing life skills such as financial literacy.

## HOW OUR NETWORK SERVES

Total Client Services: **17,283,889**

In 2013, more than nine million clients came to Catholic Charities agencies seeking food, representing the majority of client services provided.

Although food services represent the highest volume of services provided by Catholic Charities, for most clients this is only an entry point to a broader array of services accessed after a comprehensive assessment by a case manager. In fact, in 2013, Catholic Charities agencies provided an additional 7,643,322 services that address the full spectrum of human needs in a way that not only sustains them for another day, but empowers them to achieve their full potential.

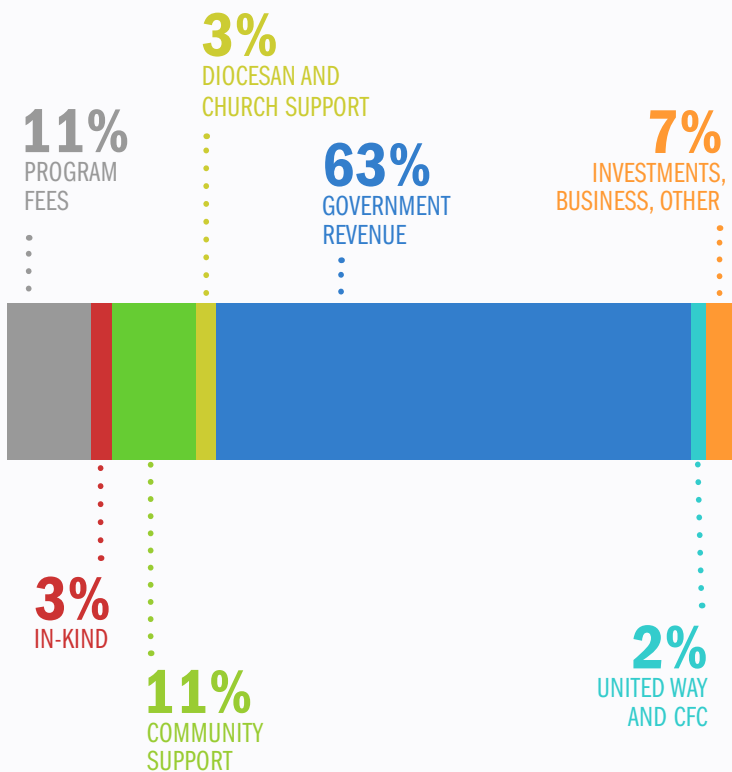

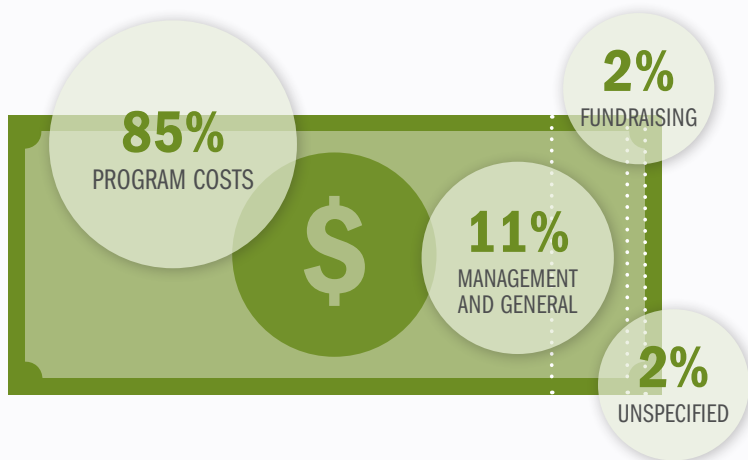
